- Title of the manuscript must be the name of file.
- Subject of the email must be “Submission 15<sup>th</sup> SAMF – (Title of Paper)
- Name of the author/s, their affiliation and contact details must be mentioned on the title page.
- All tables, graphs, images, models must be placed within the body of text on their relevant places.
- APA style must be followed with font: Times New Roman; size: 12, double spaced; with proper referencing.

## Best Paper Award

Cash prize will be awarded to five Best Papers. Best Papers will be selected based on reviewers’ evaluation and ranking. Presentation in the conference will be mandatory for eligibility of cash award.
